We would like to offer our recommendation and thanks to Central Drilling for the work they completed on one of our projects.

We recently completed the construction of a water intake for the Ngaruawahia water treatment plant, and Central Drilling were instrumental in our success. Their responsibilities involved thrusting a 355 PE pipe from a 8 metre deep water intake chamber to the centre of the Waikato River. The directional drilling had to be targeted toward pre-formed inlet and outlet holes at the bottom of the chamber. Accuracy of this task was crucial to meet design levels. Drilling continued to just above the bed of the river, where divers changed reaming heads and connected the PE pipe.
